Security of natural gas supply - a precondition for increasing consumption

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REPower EU

- REPowerEU follows Communication and toolbox published in October to respond to soaring energy prices.
- The plan focuses on:
 - 1. replenishing EU gas stocks for next winter;
 - 2. making Europe **independent** from Russian fossil fuels and **diversify** our gas supplies; and
 - **3. transitioning** to renewable gases and accelerating the European Green Deal. As well as scaling up renewables, it will also boost energy efficiency, increase electrification and address infrastructure bottlenecks.

→ Support diversification of energy supplies and phase-out Russian gas imports with special focus on cross-border and regional needs.





Transition from Coal >> N-1 rule

- Southern Gas Interconnection
 Project BiH- Croatia
 - Economic and Invesment Plan for Western Balkans – Flagship N°5
 - Access to LNG terminal KrK (US, Qatar)

→ Reinforce gas SoS in BiH and access to global/EU gas market

- New Gas Interconnection Project BiH-Serbia
 - Extention of IBS and IGB (both support by EU and EIB)
 - Further access to Turk Stream and other LNG terminals in Turkey


→ Establish regional WB gas market





BiH to speed-up reforms

- Green Agenda for Western Balkans (NECP, CO2 price, CBAM)
- Gas as transition fuel >> back-up RES, reduce pollution and H2 pathway
- Regulatory amendments
 - unbundling, third party access, network codes
 - gas storage (RU = unreliable partner)
